

Outline Of New Permit and Provisional Process

Student Enrolls In Drivers Ed

- Must be 15 or older by last day of class
- 30 hrs classroom instruction
- Final exam (70% to pass)

After Classroom Session, students take the MVD knowledge exam on the computer

Can be taken at Premier or any MVD location (70% to pass)

Once students pass they can get their Learner's Permit from any MVD office

What to bring to MVD for Learner's Permit

- Driving School Referral Card (given by Premier)
- If the student took the MVD knowledge exam at Premier the score will be in the system at the MVD
- Original Birth Certificate
- Original Social Security Card
- 2 proofs of residency (if under 18 years old)
- ✓ 1st proof can be an affidavit of residency, signed at the MVD by parent/guardian, if the address on the license is where the student lives or parent/guardian can provided an addition proof of residency
- ✓ 2nd proof has to be under the students name with current address (i.e. report card, transcript, bank statement, etc.)

Once you have a permit, book driving time online with Premier from the behind-the-wheel tab on our website

Your road test will be done right after your 7th hour of driving at Premier (70% to pass) No need to book a road test.

After all driving hours are complete you will get a Certificate of Completion from Premier

Once you have had a permit for 6 months, you can go to MVD for your Provisional License

What to bring to MVD for a Provisional License

- Certificate of completion (given by Premier)
 - Driving School Record of Completion (given by Premier)
 - 50hr driving log

- **After a year with your Provisional you can go to MVD for a unrestricted driver's license**
